DEVELOPMENT:

- 1. Starting to roll over.
- 2. Laughs out loud.
- 3. Starting to reach.
- 4. Everything goes in mouth.

ACCIDENT PREVENTION:

- 1. *Always* use a car seat. Use a rear facing seat until baby weighs 20 pounds and is at least one year of age.
- 2. Many babies are rolling over consistently at four months—watch them on the changing table or any other high surface.
- 3. Use infant seat on floor only.
- 4. Avoid smoking or hot drinks while holding baby.
- 5. Avoid toys with small parts.

NUTRITION:

- 1. Some babies (or parents) ready to start solids.
- 2. Continue breastfeeding or infant formula with iron.

ILLNESS:

- 1. First cold—Saline Nose Drops (Ocean, NaSal, etc).
- 2. Acetaminophen Drops—0.8 mL every 3-4 hours if temperature over 101 degrees rectally.

NEXT VISIT:

At six months of age.
